The stunning Jack Nicklaus designed Al Zorah Golf Club in Ajman, the newest golf course in the Middle East scheduled for official opening in December, is now accepting membership requests.

Al Zorah Golf Club is the first new championship venue in the UAE for nearly six years – after The Track in Meydan – and will initially be opening its membership to a limited number of golfers.

Given its setting, Al Zorah promises to take the golfer's breath away with its captivating 18-hole championship layout set amongst naturally preserved environment of native sandy areas, lakes and mangroves.

As Ajman's first golf course and Nicklaus Design's first solo project in the Middle East, Al Zorah will feature pristinely manicured fairways and greens alongside an abundance of natural wildlife, 12 km of waterfront and a tidal system that alters the dynamics of the course on an hourly basis.

The par-72 course is managed by Troon Golf, the world leaders in upscale golf course management.
